Formation; Circle of partners.

Mary Alice does: Circle to the left, circle to the right, into the center and back (*Into the center in my old brass wagon, back on out in my old brass wagon, into the center....*) clap your hands, tap your toe, two hand turn (with partner), dosido, circle left, circle right, forward and back, bow to your partner. Obviously you can improvise with this and use it to teach simple partner figures to young children.
